5. Signals Made Ashore

No signals will be made ashore, except for your friends waving you good-bye form the dock, wishing they were going.



7. Racing Area

The Racing area will be Tampa Bay, from Apollo Beach to the Manatee River.

8. Courses and Marks

The Course is for general guidance and direction. Please use the middle three spans of the Skyway Bridge and be careful for other vessels. The only two marks that you must prove you have taken to Port, are the start and the finish.



9. Starting and Finishing Lines

The Start line will be the Hillsborough Cut C Channel Tower Outbound Range Rear Light, located just out of the Apollo Beach Channel.

When you pass the Cut C Channel Tower, you will take a cell phone photo and text the photo and the vessel name to 813-404-5517. The time you text the photo is your start time.

Cut C Channel Tower 27° 47.213' N - 82° 27.048' W

The Finish Line is at the beginning of the Outer Mark Manatee River Entrance leading up from Tampa Bay to the Manatee River.

When you pass the Red Channel Marker at the beginning of the channel, as designated on the map, you will take a cell phone photo and text the photo and the vessel name to 813-404-5517. The time you text the photo is your finish time.

Outer Mark Manatee River Entrance 27° 32.661′ N - 82° 40.693′ W

10. Engine Use.

You may use your engine for up to two (2) hours of the race or any other time where safety and navigation require such use.

11. Time Limit


There is no time limit, but we would hope that you make it before 6:00 p.m., in order to take advantage of daylight coming through the channel at the Manatee River and

Protests shall be delivered to your own personal deity, spouse, significant other, or those on board your vessel.

5.2 The Start line will be the Hillsborough Cut C Channel Tower Outbound Range Rear Light, located just out of the Apollo Beach Channel.

When you pass the Cut C Channel Tower, you will take a cell phone photo and text the photo and the vessel name to 813-404-5517. The time you text the photo is your start time.

5.3 The Finish Line is at the beginning of the Channel leading up from Tampa Bay to the Manatee River.

When you pass the Red Channel Marker at the beginning of the channel, as designated on the map, you will take a cell phone photo and text the photo and the vessel name to 813-404-5517. The time you text the photo is your finish time.

6 PENALTY SYSTEM

7 SCORING

A boat's regatta score will be the time from start to finish, adjusted for numerous factors. Most of them completely made up.

8 Penalty System

Again, what's a penalty? After all, we are letting you use your engine for up to 2 hours.

9 Berthing and Anchoring

Free dockage at TSS is available. Make reservations with the dock master at by contacting Don Swartz by September 21, 2020. After that, dockage is "as available".

Once in the Manatee River, we will all be anchoring overnight at Emerson Point. Please bring and anchor and ensure your anchor light on your vessel is operational. If you have a dinghy, there are wonderful facilities that can be easily reached. If you do not have a dinghy, we are here to help! Do not let your lack of a dinghy be an excuse not to race!

10 Radio Communication

10.1 The Race Committee will begin broadcasting at Saturday morning on the channel listed in the sailing instructions. Weather conditions, course selection, count down and infractions will be broadcast.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be presented for several categories, all to be made up and completely random. Although, all vessels sailing under the Skyway Bridge will receive a special award from TSS...the fabled golden coin!
